Beki is survived by her husband, partner and best friend of 38 years Kelly Wilson and her daughters Kati Jo and Maggi, all of Montgomery, Texas; her mother, Carolyn Ledwig of Millett, Texas; and brother Josh Wadsworth and wife Shanna of Falls City, Texas.

Visitation will be Friday, January 14 at Roberson Funeral Home from 5-7 pm. Funeral celebration will be held at Brush Country Cowboy Church in George West, Texas beginning at 1 pm with graveside to follow at the Ray Point Cemetery.
