



Billy Joe Furlow

Billy Joe Furlow went to be with our Heavenly Father on September 25, 2012. He was born October 15, 1923 to Cleo and Robert (Bob) Furlow in Alvord, Texas. He goes home to reunite with his wife, Joyce Cook Furlow, his parents, and step-mother Wilma Furlow. He is also reunited with two brothers, Vernon and Clarence and two sisters, Beatrice Mahan and Margaret Cisna. Bill is survived by daughter Annalee (Doug) Harvey and son John Richard Furlow and two step-grandchildren.

Bill was an outstanding football player for the Three Rivers Bulldogs in the late 30's and early 40's. By December of 1942, he had enough credits to graduate and World War II was breaking out. The school let him go fight for our freedom; therefore, he missed his own graduation. His dad, Bob Furlow, a long time resident of Three Rivers got his diploma for him. Because of these two factors – being such an excellent football player and one of the first from Three Rivers to go to the war – Three Rivers ISD named the football field after him which he always considered such an honor.

When he received an honorable discharge in 1945, he went to work for Magnolia Oil Company (now Mobil Oil), living in Alice, Freer, Premont, and Odem. He retired in 1986 and he and Joyce happily moved back to Three Rivers. They were active members in the First Baptist Church, Three Rivers. Visitation will be held from 5-7 PM on Wednesday, September 26, 2012 at

Roberson Funeral Home in Three Rivers.
