Elizabeth Daniel Spangler Roberson, affectionately known in her early years as “EBOO” and in her later years as “Nonnie”, of Falfurrias, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August, 27, 2013 of natural causes.

Elizabeth was born in Waco, Tx. To the late Charles Pinkney and Bessie Legare Spangler on Oct. 1, 1925. Ebo graduated from Uvalde High School, Uvalde, Texas in 1943 and continued her education at Trinity University and SMU until recruited by the United States Government to go to work in the Pentagon for the war effort.
