Guadalupe "Lupe" DeLeon, 70, passed away on April 28, 2016 in Falfurrias, Texas.

Visitation and viewing will be held at the Church of the Brethren in Falfurrias on May 12, 2016 at 9am. Funeral service will be held at the Church of the Brethren in Falfurrias on May 12, 2016 at 10 am with Pastor Alvin Roberts (ret.) officiating. Burial at the church cemetery will follow.

Lupe was born on May 7, 1945 near Falfurrias, Texas. He graduated from Falfurrias High School before attending Indiana University, where he became the first person in his family to receive a college diploma. He began his lifelong career in education in Lansing, Michigan, where he taught high school Spanish, English and Driver's Education. Lupe moved to Casa Grande, Arizona, where he taught Social Studies and English while earning a Master's degree from Northern Arizona University. He taught for another twelve years in El Paso, Texas before retiring.

After his retirement, Lupe became active in the Baptist Church in Chaparral, New Mexico, where he used his teaching skills to spread the word of God. His faith eventually guided him to Alice, Texas, where he continued his work as the Lord's servant until his passing.

Lupe is survived by his wife Diana; sons Adrian and Isaac DeLeon; daughters Elena Sanders and Diana Isabel DeLeon; sister Hortencia Garcia; and

brothers Juan Pedro, Ignacio, Tomas, Felix, and Martin Jr. He is preceded in death by his parents Martin and Juanita (Salazar) DeLeon; and brothers Cresencio, Bernardo, and Eusebio.
