Howard Pendley, age 61, passed away on February 7, 2023 unexpectedly following an extended illness. He was born on August 14, 1961 in Wichita Falls to Ceaphas and Virginia (Maxwell) Pendley.

He was a business owner in Beeville, owning and operating Pendley Appliance and AC Service. Howard began working in the family business; Pendley Appliance, at the age of 14, and stayed with the company after Ceaphas Pendley retired leaving Howard as sole proprietor until his cancer diagnosis in July 2022. He married Mary Jackson in 2006 and she passed away after a long illness, in which Howard was faithfully by her side and has truly grieved for her since her death.

He was a terrific uncle to his 5 nephews and 2 special nieces; Aaron, Amber, Justin, Ian, Mitch, Spencer, Chelsea and Whitney. He did everything he could to keep them occupied with go-carts, minibikes, ziplines...anything dangerous. He loved his parents and helped take care of them, especially after his mom's first stroke in 2001, at which time he took over the business. Howard has been a constant in all of our lives, and anyone who ever met him, never forgot him; he touched their lives forever. The best way to sum up Howard's life is that he was always true to himself and to everyone around him. He made every decision based off the truths that he believed in and those truths were reflected in his actions, towards anyone he met. He could

be generous to a fault, and yet he knew when to use tough love...whatever the situation required and everyone who met him walked away knowing he was truly a man of integrity. He was true to his work; if he said it, you could count on it as done. He will truly be missed. There is no way to fill the void each of us will carry in our heart, because he was such a big part of it.

He is survived by his parents and his brother Archie Pendley, and his sister, Cindy Rivers.
