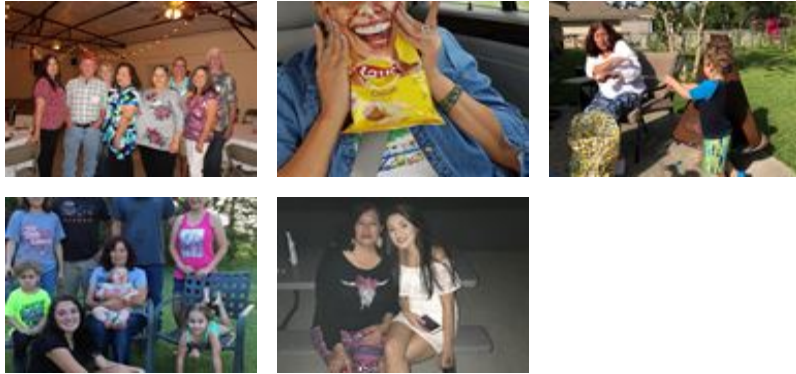
A Memorial Service will be on Wednesday, Jan.1, 2020 at 2 PM at the Brush Country Cowboy Church.
