He then enlisted in the Army Air Borne as a paratrooper until he retired in 1968 as a Master Sargent. He was a proud veteran of three wars; WWII, Korea and Vietnam.

In 1972 Marvin married June Elizabeth Goodman who was the love of his life. They lived in central Louisiana until 1975 when he hired on with Dowell Services. Dowell transferred him to Alice, Texas. After a couple of years Marvin established Alice Machine and Welding Company. Marvin and Huey operated the business and June ran the office for over 20 years. Marvin was a Shriner and a big supporter of the Shriner's Hospital for Children.

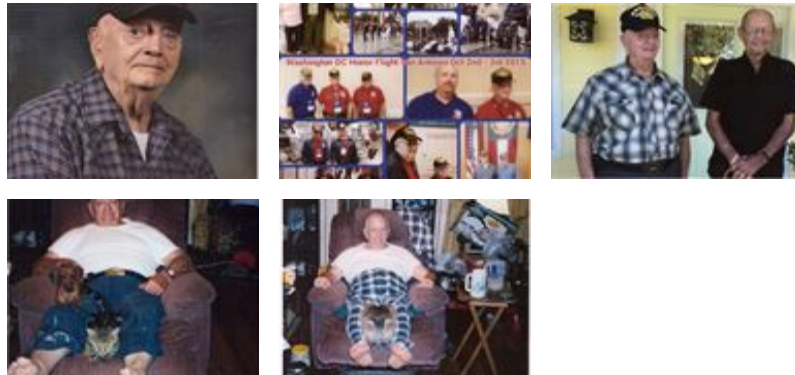
