Mildred Bomar, born March 1, 1930 passed away October 3, 2013 after a long illness in Pearland, Texas. Mildred was the daughter of George W. Smith and Bonnie M. Smith of Three Rivers, TX. Mildred graduated from Three Rivers High School, and was taught by her mother in law, Leila Bomar, who introduced her to her son Royse H. Bomar, who had returned from serving in the US Navy. Royse and Mildred married May 2, 1948 in her parents' home in Three Rivers, Texas.

Mildred and Royse adopted two children Mark Howard in February of 1956 and Laura Jane born in November of 1960. Royse worked for Humble Oil Company on the King Ranch in Kingsville, Texas. Royse was transferred to Corpus Christi and then to Houston in 1970, where he retired in the early 1980's.

Mildred was a stay at home mom and was a loving wife and mother, who did a fantastic job of taking care of her family. She and Royse went into the antique business after Royse retired from Exxon. They enjoyed traveling the east coast every year and also traveled overseas.
