During and after graduating High School, Steve worked for the Goliad County Sheriff's Department as a dispatcher, with the Goliad EMS, and for Doug Mundine Construction Co. Steve then served in the United States Marine Corps for five years and attained the rank of Sergeant (Sgt.). Following his time in the Corps, he attended Hallmark Technical School in San Antonio TX. Steve completed the Victoria Texas Police Academy and once again worked for the Goliad County Sheriff's Dept. as a Jailer and Reserve Deputy. Steve served in the Border Patrol and was stationed in Laredo TX and Douglas AZ. Prior to his diagnosis with bladder cancer, he worked offshore and for the oil field as a pipe fitter and instrumentation specialist.
