Turner Pryor Brown, also known as Pryor, passed away on March 21, 2026 from his valiant fight with pancreatic cancer. He was surrounded by family and friends up until his passing.

Pryor was born on January 10, 1949 in Beeville, Texas. From a young age, he was mischievous and rambunctious. His sense of humor always lit up any room he walked into and that carried on well into his adult life.

After graduating from George West High School, he went to Uvalde Junior College and Steven F. Austin University.

Shortly after attending the previously mentioned colleges, he worked for Harold Cattle Company. After some time, he went on to work with Haliburton in the oilfield on both the ground and in off-shore drilling rigs. A few years passed, and he grew restless; he wanted to explore our beautiful country, so he left his job and became a truck driver for J.B. Hunt and later D.S.I. He drove through forty-eight states and Canada.

He medically retired at fifty-six years old and started his harrowing journey through over thirty surgeries. Despite the pain, he kept his strong devotion to the Lord and his wife and daughter.

He carried on for numerous years, always helping those in need. He participated in the Jail Ministry for several years as well as the Gedions. He faithfully served in the Live Oak Cemetery Association for a couple of years, marking over two-hundred unmarked graves with a close friend, Bernard

Lemley, and his daughter, Kerra Grace Brown.
